Summer 2017 at Carlyon Beach

Carlyon Beach events and refreshments will be run this year by Cakey Tea Promotions, a company set up by local businessman and Fowey hotel owner Tony Goodman.

“Various events are currently in the planning stages but we can announce that The Offbeat Bar will be in residence for the 2017 summer season and will be serving hot and cold Cornish beverages from an undercover bar plus rooftop terrace based around a 1940’s Bedford truck with live music a regular feature,” said Mr Goodman.

“We will also be joined on a daily basis by Rob Pollard and his Smoking Hog BBQ Company who will be providing a range of the finest Cornish meats plus a variety of pop ups including Keep Cornwall Fed, an organisation which donates a meal to someone living in food poverty for every commercial meal they sell, Angels in the Kitchen and the Cornish Waffle Box. Other pop ups will be announced throughout the season.”

From Good Friday, The Love Snack will be open selling Cornish pasties, snacks and soft drinks and Kelly’s Ice Cream will be in residence from mid May until October.

“Miracle Theatre will be returning this year on 19th July with their new production, The Third Policeman and tickets will be on sale soon. A new concept of outdoor cinema sessions is also being developed to incorporate hot tubs and plans are underway for the first ever national beach cricket tournament in September featuring teams from the Lords Taverners, England Ladies and Lancashire Legends.”

Cornwall’s only beach Frisbee golf course will also be open for business again this year. The course was launched last summer and has a popular draw for locals and visitors alike.

Elm Yoga will be holding sessions on Saturday mornings and Lovely Yoga on Sunday mornings.
